**WHO CAN RIDE**

Anyone 18 years and over can bicycle the 252, 157 and 92-mile events. There is no age limit for the 45-mile event; however, cyclists 14 and under must qualify. Contact Event Headquarters at (520) 745-2033 for qualifications & rules.

**DEADLINE** 1 hour before your scheduled event begins or upon reaching event limit.

**PRIZE CERTIFICATES** are gift certificates which can be redeemed for merchandise or services (i.e., bicycles, clothing, food, etc.) at any of Perimeter Bicycling's Information & Redemption centers around the country. Cyclists collecting \$100 or more receive two Prize Certificates for every \$10 collected; each Prize Certificate has a value of \$1.00. Unless instructed to the contrary by a law enforcement official, I must comply with all traffic regulations. **Cochise County Cycling Classic is finished at 2:00 a.m. on October 12, 2008, and all course support will be closed. In signing this waiver I agree to be totally responsible for my own safety and support after that time.**

In consideration of my signing this agreement, I, the undersigned, intending to be legally bound, hereby, for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release any and all rights and claims for damages, including, but not limited to, the loss of my bicycle, helmet or any other personal items, I may have against the State of Arizona, State of New Mexico, Arizona Department of Transportation, Arizona Department of Public Safety, City of Douglas, Cochise County, Douglas ARC, Perimeter Bicycling Association of America, Inc., any and all governmental and tribal agencies, and any and all sponsors and their representatives, successors, and assigns for any and all injuries suffered by me as a result of taking part in this bicycling event and any related activities. I attest that I will participate in this event as a bicycling entrant; I will wear an CPSC/SNELL-approved bicycle helmet; that I am physically fit and have sufficiently trained for the completion of this event and that my physical condition has been verified by a licensed medical doctor.
