Special Notes for 165-Mile Event Cyclists

- All cyclists in this distance must ride fully supported by a personal follow vehicle and support crew. Min. two (2) crew recommended.
- Legal bicycle lighting is MANDATORY for all cyclists before dawn and after dusk.
- Crews of this event are REQUIRED to attend the pre-rider meeting Friday, October 6, 2017 at Expo.

RIDER WAIVER FORM: ALL RIDERS MUST READ AND SIGN THIS FORM.

As a participant in **Cochise County Cycling Classic**, I must obey all laws of the State of Arizona that may apply to my activities during this event, especially traffic laws. All traffic signals, devices, and other traffic rules apply to me during this event. Unless instructed to the contrary by a law enforcement official, I must comply with all traffic regulations. **Each distance event of the Cochise County Cycling Classic finishes at the following "cut off" times on event day, Saturday, October 7, 2017: 27-mile event at 11:30am; 47-mile event at 1:00pm; 95-mile event at 4:00pm; and 165-mile event at 10:30pm. At the stated times all course support will end. In signing this ACCIDENT WAIVER and RELEASE OF LIABILITY, I agree to be totally responsible for my own safety and support after the stated cut off times.**

In consideration of my signing this agreement, I, the undersigned, intending to be legally bound, hereby, for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release any and all rights and claims for damages, including, but not limited to the loss of my bicycle, helmet or any other personal items, I may have against the State of Arizona, Arizona Department of Transportation, Arizona Department of Public Safety, City of Douglas, Cochise County, Douglas ARC, Perimeter Bicycling Association of America, Inc., Cenpatco Integrated Care, Canyon Vista Medical Center, any and all governmental and tribal agencies, and any and all underwriters and their representatives, successors, and assigns for any and all injuries suffered by me as a result of taking part in this bicycling event and any related activities. I attest that I will participate in this event as a bicycling entrant; I will wear a CPSC-approved bicycle helmet; that I am physically fit and have sufficiently trained for the completion of this event and that a licensed medical doctor has verified my physical condition. Further, I hereby grant full permission to any and all the foregoing to use any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures, recordings or any other record of this event for any legitimate purpose.

The event utilizes open public roads, which may or may not be maintained by local municipalities, cities, counties, and/or the State. The event is not responsible for the condition and maintenance of the roads. Road hazards are always possible and in entering this event, and signing this waiver, I agree and understand that I must be alert to all road hazards, including but not limited to: pot holes, uneven pavement, road cracks, road debris, unfinished construction, and motor vehicle traffic.

I understand that aero-type and other similar auxiliary handlebars are prohibited in the 95-mile, 47-mile and 27-mile events of the Cochise County Cycling Classic and that utilizing such bars may result in my disqualification. Furthermore, I understand that I am responsible for all my personal items including, but not limited to, cameras, cell phones, clothing, bicycles, etc.

I understand that this event is "timed" and that I may or may not receive a device (transponder) that will electronically record my finish time. If I receive an electronic timing device, I understand that I am fully responsible for mounting this device properly on my bicycle and that if I do not mount it properly, no time will be recorded for me. If the event is "manually" timed, that is, an electronic device is not used, I shall fully cooperate with instructions given by event officials to record my finish time. Further, I understand that the time recorded is "gun time," i.e., my time begins at the "starting gun" and finishes when I cross the finish line.

I understand all fees and collected contributions are not refundable or transferable to another person or event. Rider Numbers are also not transferable to another person or event.
