RIDER WAIVER FORM: ALL RIDERS MUS					
As a participant in Cochise County Cycling Classic, I must obey all laws of the State of Arizona that may apply to my activities during this event, especially traffic laws. All traffic signals, devices, and other traffic rules apply to me during this event. Unless instructed to the contrary by a law enforcement official, I must comply with all traffic regulations. Each distance event of the Cochise County Cycling Classic finishes at the following "cut off" times on event day, Saturday, October 7, 2017: 27-mile event at 1:30am; 47-mile event at 1:00pm; 95-mile event at 4:00pm; and 165-mile event at 10:30pm. At the stated times all course support will end. In signing this ACCIDENT WAIVER and RELEASE OF LIABILITY, I agree to be totally responsible for my own safety and support after the stated cut off times.					
In consideration of my signing this agreement, I, the undersigned, intending to be legally bound, hereby, for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release any and all rights and claims for damages, including, but not limited to the loss of my bicycle, helmet or any other personal items, I may have against the State of Arizona, Arizona Department of Transportation, Arizona Department of Public Safety, City of Douglas, Cochise County, Douglas ARC, Perimeter Bicycling Association of America, Inc., Cenpatico Integrated Care, Canyon Vista Medical Center, any and all governmental and tribal agencies, and any and all underwriters and their representatives, successors, and assigns for any and all injuries suffered by me as a result of taking part in this bicycling event and any related activities.
