

Speed Bumps on 18th Street

(aka El Tour Roller Coaster Road)

There are 4 speed tables on 18th Street between 6th Avenue and the I-10 frontage road. Volunteers are needed to alert cyclists **before** the speed bumps by shouting, cowbells, pom poms or any other fun and encouraging methods.

Volunteers should plan to arrive from the south (22nd Street) and park on the side streets off of 18th Street to avoid barricades. Distribute yourself equally between the speed bumps. Please be in place no later than 7:30am (the Fun Ride starts at 8am).

Volunteers should position themselves east of the speed bumps, on both sides of the street to alert riders to slow down. Volunteers should switch to the west side of the speed bumps as cyclists make their way back to the start.

There will be a lull before the cyclists return; relax and get ready to encourage the riders on their way back to the finish. Bike Patrol will release volunteers after the last rider (about 10 am).

1st Speed table – on 18th Street, east of 7th Avenue

2nd Speed Table - on 18th Street, east of Convent

3rd Speed Table - on 18th Street, east of 9th Avenue

4th Speed Table - on 18th Street, west of 11th Avenue
