



El Tour Volunteer Parking

Thank you for being part of El Tour de Tucson! The Expo and Start/Finish Line are located downtown and parking downtown can be challenging so please plan your volunteer experience in advance.

Perimeter Bicycling does not provide volunteer parking passes.

Be aware that even during El Tour parking laws are strictly enforced. Nothing can ruin the warm glow of your volunteer experience like a costly parking ticket. Parking behind the Armory Park Senior Center, within 10' of an alley, a fire hydrant or an intersection will get you an unwanted ticket.

With over 13,000 spaces, parking Downtown can be easy and convenient. Please allow plenty of time to park and get to your destination in a leisurely fashion. There is plenty of conveniently located on-street parking, parking garages and parking lots in Downtown Tucson, on 4th Avenue and along the [Sun Link modern streetcar](#) route. Metered street parking is free after 5pm and weekends (confirm at the individual meter).
